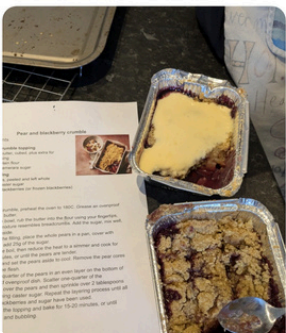
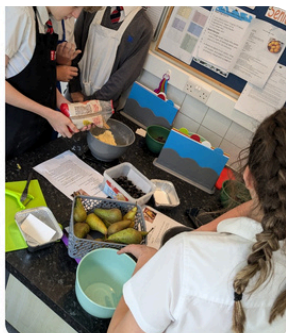


All the donations go the wonderful Charity Tayfen House
